In November 2022, the voters of Brazos

County approved the \$100 million TRIP-22 bond program by 67%.






National Highway Construction Cost Index

Nationally, roadway construction costs have increased approximately 70% since 2022.



Since 2022, TxDOT construction costs have increased by 68%.
